Fundraising Update: Presented by Krystal

1. Our **Go Fund Me site** is ready and live. Krystal will send out information this week. It will be a group fundraiser with a starting goal of \$5000.
2. Our **Gerten's Mum** fundraiser is up and running. This is an individual athlete fundraiser.

Gym Move:

We will be moving back to our gym at the end of next week. Jen shared pictures of the updated space. Everything is painted white. Unfortunately, there are not funds in the construction budget for paint or decorating. We discussed having the booster club help decorate.

Ideas: Paint walls or stripes on walls? Logos? Photos? Quotes? Trophy display?

Wall Paw Idea: Fundraiser to pay supplies or support the program? Decorate the wall with paw prints. Maybe made of wood or vinyl or painted on with a stencil. Each could have a cheerleader's name or cheer family's name. Maybe different sizes for different donation amounts.

We could potentially also do a wood paw kit that could be painted at home as a separate fundraising idea.

Decorating needs to be approved by Community Ed before we purchase supplies or start decorating.

Normally we would do a grand reopening but due to COVID we can't have any one additional in the gym space. Maybe we could do something outside that is COVID friendly?
