## **Competition Discussion:**

1. Registration deadline will be 10/4/20.

3. Comp T-Shirts
  - a. Karen will price options thru Town Sports
  - b. Will be pre-order only
  - c. Long sleeve as these sold the best at our comp last year
  - d. We will mail/deliver to their school.
  - e. Set up payment either thru Town Sports or using our Square account
  - f. Mari has the licensing to the Sanderson Sisters image if we would like to use.
  - g. We will work on the t-shirt design this week via Group Me.
4. Trophies
  - a. Number per division will depend on number of team registered. Maybe top 3?
  - b. We will wait to see the number registered.
  - c. Can order on 10/4 (registration deadline)
5. Our team will need film at the high school and mats will need to be moved.
6. Judges
  - a. We would ideally like 4 judges – 3 main and 1 safe/deduction judge.
  - b. Jen has talked with two judges already that are willing and has messages out to others. They do not need to be local as they will review videos from home.
  - c. We are unsure of the fee per judge as this is virtual and a shorter time commitment. We will wait to see how many teams/routines are registered and then determine the fee.

1. Middle school camp refunds have been processed through Square.
2. Comp registration fees discussion: Can team fees be paid online through our Square account? Historically, most come as checks from the school. Many unfortunately arrive after the competition. We will have to cover the costs until the checks arrive. Square would work if a Booster club was paying the fees. Will need to stay with checks.

**Fundraising Update:** Presented by Krystal

1. Mum fundraiser went well.
  - a. 208 plants were sold
  - b. They were very good quality and definitely would repeat next year.
  - c. Would see if we could get a Saturday delivery date next year so more families could help volunteer to sort and make it easier for pick up.
2. MN Brands for Good fundraiser
  - a. This will run in October.
  - b. It is an individual fundraiser.
  - c. This is a no contact fundraiser. All items are purchased online and shipped directly to the buyer.

- d. This one will include Christmas items and wreaths.
3. Kline Foods – Fudge
- a. This is an individual fundraiser.
  - b. New this year, there is online ordering.
  - c. Families will still need to pick up their fudge at the cheer gym and distribute.
  - d. We will make sure that holiday flavors are included.
4. Chipotle
- a. Is offering a digital event!
  - b. We are in early stage of checking into this one but our program would be given a code to scan when they order.
  - c. They give 33% of the order back to FCCT
  - d. It looks to be ongoing and the code can be scanned more than once.
  - e. Many of our cheerleaders like Chipotle so may be an easy way to give back.
5. Tap House
- a. Our annual Santa Breakfast at the Tap House is likely a no this year due to COVID restrictions.
  - b. Krystal will check to see if they are offering any other fundraising in its place.
6. El Charro
- a. They would like to host an event – A FCCT night – where families could come and eat or pick up take out. A portion of the proceeds would go to FCCT.
